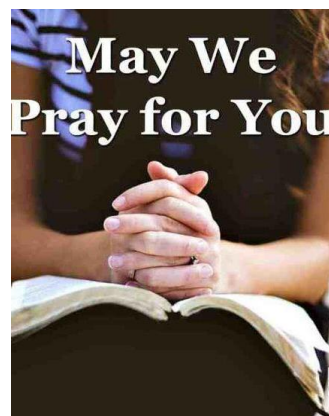

FPCM Renter Spotlight Moms Demand Action FM is a grassroots organization of moms and others who advocate for gun safety. We believe that 10 people dying every day from gun violence in this country is unacceptable and we know we can do better. Moms Demand Action is non-partisan because people in all parties share our concern that more guns are not the

answer, and know that we can both support the second amendment and pass common sense legislation that will make our communities safer. The local group meets monthly, on the third Tuesday of each month to determine how we can influence local, state, and national elected officials; support survivors of gun violence; and consider how we can creatively engage our community in the work of reducing gun violence.

There are more than 6 million Moms Demand Action volunteers working in every state in the country. There are no paid staff people in Moms Demand Action, including our founder Shannon Watts. If you have a group that would be interested in a presentation from either a Moms Demand Action educator, or a volunteer who is trained in the curriculum we have for ensuring safety with guns in the home – Be SMART – we have volunteers trained in both.
