Noisy Pentecost Offering

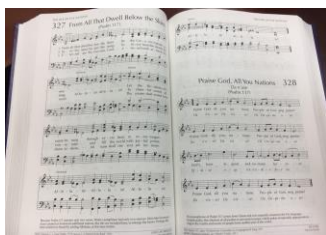
