God, from my youth you have taught me. Psalm 71:17

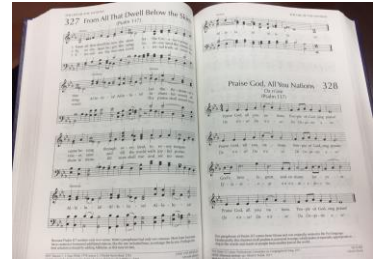
