nearly two years our church has used gluten free bread for communion.

This choice was made so as to be more inclusive and welcoming for those with this dietary need.

Similarly, we serve grape juice, rather than wine. We also want to make the serving of the elements

simple, not confusing or complicated. That way worshipers can focus their attention on Christ and on the deep meaning of communion, rather than on the process of serving or the elements themselves.
